

Noncustodial parent CSS Profile

If your biological or adoptive parents do not live together, some colleges that require the CSS Profile may also require you to complete a second CSS Profile application. This additional application asks the same questions and should be filled out by your noncustodial parent.

If a college requires an additional CSS Profile for your noncustodial parent, the **form must be completed** in order to be eligible for scholarships and grants from that college.

After adding colleges to your CSS Profile, the application and dashboard will indicate whether or not an additional CSS Profile will be required from your noncustodial parent.

Other Parent

At least one of your colleges or programs requires that both of your biological/adoptive parents, not just the one who completed this application, submit the CSS Profile application.

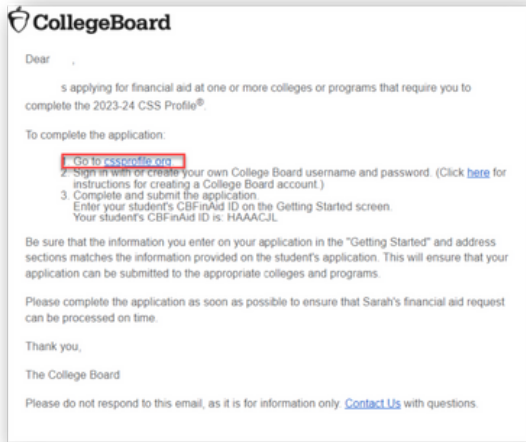
If your noncustodial parent is able to complete this form:

- Email the login information directly to your noncustodial parent
- Have your noncustodial parent create a new College Board account
- Ensure that your noncustodial parent completes their CSS Profile. The information they provide in the "Student Section" must match exactly with the information in the original CSS Profile application completed by your custodial parent.

Are there any exceptions?

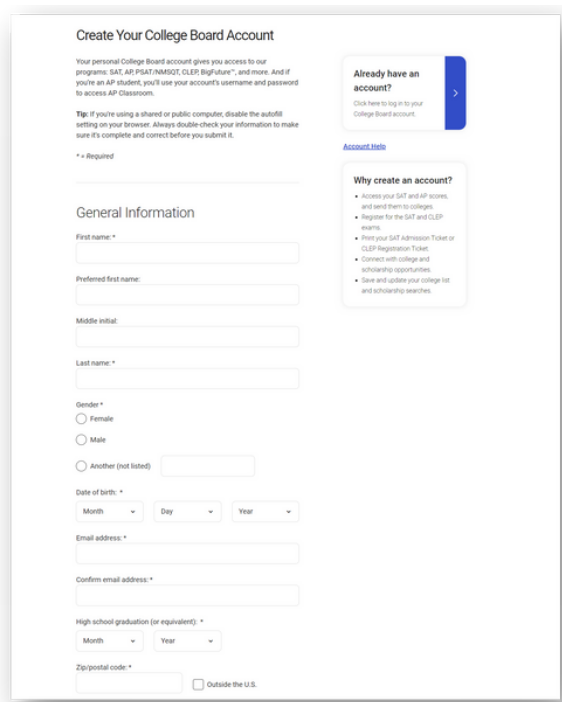
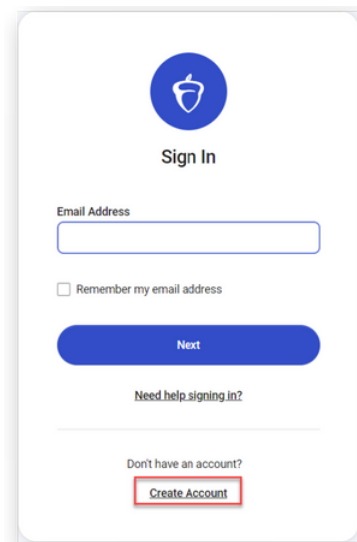
- If you have **no contact with your noncustodial parent** or **have other special circumstances**, you may not be required to fill out the additional CSS Profile, or you may be able to waive this requirement if requested.
- If you are **an independent student** (e.g., in legal guardianship), your colleges may or may not require this form. Your uAspire advisor can help you call each college to see what their requirements are.

How to create an account



When your enter your noncustodial parent's email address, they will get an email like this instructing them to either sign in or create an account. They can also go directly to cssprofile.collegeboard.org

If your noncustodial parent does not yet have a College Board account, click "Create Account".
